Cecile Sarabian spoke about hygiene behaviours in a variety of primate species and Morganne Allanic told us about her research into grooming patterns as a measure of social tolerance in captive chimpanzees and bonobos. Josue Alejandro presented his poster on evaluating stress in male Japanese macaques living in two different types of outdoor enclosures. The audience provided a variety of suggestions for enhancing the presentations, from the overall structure of the talk to the colours used for text and background.
