In this first seminar of the academic year, we first discussed how you should approach grant writing in general. We then gave an overview of the application process for the JSPS Research Fellowships for Young Scientists (RFYS), with the focus on the doctoral (DC1/DC2) level fellowships*.

*Note to applicants for JSPS <u>postdoctoral</u> fellowships: The "PD" category of RFYS requires Japanese citizenship or permanent resident status. If you are neither, you will likely be applying for the <u>JSPS Postdoctoral Fellowships for</u> <u>Research in Japan</u>, which is a different fellowship program with earlier deadlines (make sure to check with your prospective host).
