Grant Writing Masterclass

It's that time of year again where hopeful graduate students will be writing their grants for the DC1 or DC2 fellowships from the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), which are do in early April. Each year, we take this opportunity to introduce students to the art of grant writing. While the focus might be on the JSPS format, the concepts are broadly applicable to any grant students may wish to apply for. Therefore, we highly recommend all of you to attend.

This is a block of <u>two</u> workshops, in which we will first introduce you to to the grant writing process (on <u>Wednesday April 17th</u>) and provide a number of tips to consider when preparing your application. Along the way, we look also at key grant statistics regarding the JSPS-DC1/2 system, go over the JSPS application form and what is expected in each section, and then work toward transforming research ideas into concrete, understandable and fundable research proposal. The second workshop (<u>Wednesday April 24th</u>) will more specifically go over current applications to be submitted to JSPS by students, providing advice toward building competitive applications based on the concepts discussed in the previous week.

So, come out and learn more about the wonderful world of grant writing something all of us spend a lot of time on as researchers, and can always improve through practice and critical thinking. For any veterans of the process, we also look forward to your experience and wisdom in helping those just starting out make the best step forward.
