Writing grants is a part of life as a researcher. Ikuma explained what makes the difference between being awarded the grant, or not. Beyond your proposed research and your scientific record, it is the written proposal itself that can put you a cut above your competition. Remember that the reviewers are human, make it easy for them to read and remember that they are unlikely to be specialists in your field. When checking over your own draft proposal, it is difficult to assess it as someone reading it for the first time without the relevant background. Reading others' applications can help you to see things from a reviewer's perspective and so improve your own grant writing skills.
